

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH DORE & ASSOCIATES. FOR THE FY 2019 CDBG MARION OF DEMOLITION PROJECTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance # 2020-085 authorized advertising for formal bids to for the demolition of 223-227 N. Main St., and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2021 seven bids were received, and

WHEREAS, Dore & Associates submitted the lowest base bid in the amount of \$78,600, and

WHEREAS the FY 2019 CDBG Formula Allocation grant has \$70,000 for Clearance Activity and the Marion County Land Reutilization Corporation as property owner will contribute \$8,600

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety be directed to enter a contract with Dore & Associates for the demolition of 223-227 N. Main St. in the amount of \$78,600

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable from the Community Development Block Grant FY 2019 Formula (Allocation) grant in collaboration with the Marion County Land Reutilization Corporation

Section 3. That it is desirable to allocate the award the contract since the building is in a deteriorated and unsafe condition and poses a threat to public safety.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof: and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council: otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
